A candidate may only apply for a re-mark in a subject if the mark for the subject is within 3% of a higher symbol, e.g. 27%, 37%, 47%, 57%, 67% or 77%.

- 1.1. A candidate may apply for the re-mark of his/her examination scripts at the prescribed fee. The application may only be completed online at www.sacai.org.za

THE SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION IN FEBRUARY/MARCH HAS BEEN DISCONTINUED and is therefore no longer administered and managed by SACAI.

A new examination is available during May/June where candidates can improve their results or complete outstanding results.

The closing date for May/June online examination application: 28 February 2022.

CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY:

- Candidates who were absent with a valid reason (medically unfit, death in the immediate family or other special reasons*) from one or more external question papers, may register for the May/June examination.
- Candidates who want to improve their overall achievement status, or only want to improve the achievement of a subject, may register for the May/June examination.
- In the case where a candidate was absent for one or more papers in the current NSC November exam with a valid reason, the candidate has the choice whether to write only the outstanding papers or all the papers.
- In a case where an irregularity is being investigated from the November exams, provisional enrolment for May/June examination may be granted to the candidate concerned, pending the outcome of the investigation.
- Candidates who were unable to write or complete one or more of the previous November examination question papers for reasons **other than illness/injury or death in the family**, may apply to write the May/June examination, provided that a written report is submitted by the SACAI NSC Institution or Principal of the Independent School to the Head of the Assessment Body, SACAI CEO Mr Keith Maseko.

NB: Documentary proof substantiating reason for absenteeism must be submitted to SACAI head office to ensure entry to the May/June examination. The Statement of Results should also be presented for proof of the previous November examinations registration or previous 2014 to date Umalusi certificates or previous Grade 12 Statements of Results.

WHAT PROCESS NEEDS TO BE FOLLOWED IF I DO NOT QUALIFY TO WRITE THE MAY/JUNE NSC EXAMINATION?

Candidates, who do not qualify to write the May/June NSC examination, have the following options:

- Re-enrol for the NSC as a Part time repeater candidate at a SACAI NSC Institution without delay.
- NSC Institution list available on the SACAI-web (www.sacai.org.za).
- Exams will take place in October/November of the respective year.

ANNEXURE A

- Candidates are urged to get their Statements of Results from their SACAI NSC designated examination centre or SACAI Independent school where they wrote the NSC exams.
- Result queries should be submitted for investigation within 30 days after the release of results.
- Candidates must ensure that names and identity numbers (Copy of ID document) reflect correctly on their Statement of Results and report any required corrections to SACAI before 30/05/2022.
