

ANNOUNCEMENT OF MAY/JUNE EXAMINATION RESULTS 2022

The opening up of the May/June NSC examination being regarded as an independent, stand-alone examination with effect from May/June 2022, SACAI candidates that wrote the previous October/November examinations, in the subjects concerned, from 2008 were allowed to write the 2022 May/June examination.

WHAT IS THE ROLE OF UMALUSI?

Umalusi is responsible for the quality assurance of assessment in the Grade 12-year and issues the 2022 May/June National Senior Certificate to successful NSC candidates. Umalusi approves the NSC resulting after standardisation.

DATE OF RELEASE

2022 May/June National Senior Certificate examinations will conclude on **10 June 2022** and Umalusi will announce the outcome of the examinations on Friday, **22 July 2022**.

The results will be announced on Friday, 22 July 2022.

This is, however, subject to Umalusi's processing of marks running according to schedule. The examination centres will be informed via SMS should it become evident that there will be a delay in the release of the results.

ANNOUNCEMENT PROCEDURE

The original Statement of Results will be couriered to the **NSC examination centres** from **26 July 2022**, in time for the candidates to collect from **27-28 July 2022**. Candidates are urged to get their statements of results from their SACAI NSC examination centre or SACAI Independent school where they wrote the NSC examination.

- Result queries should be submitted for investigation **within 30 days after the release** of results directly to SACAI.
- Candidates must ensure that names and identity numbers reflect correctly on their statement of results and report any required corrections to the SACAI Examination Board before **12 August 2022**.

Candidates will be able to view their results on the SACAI portal from **Friday, 22 July 2022 from 12:00**. Keying in the candidate's **examination and ID numbers will allow access to the portal**.



The pass requirements for each of these levels:

Higher certificate pass requirements

- Must obtain 40% in your Home Language.
- Must obtain at least 40% in **two** other subjects.
- Must obtain at least 30% for **three** other subjects.

It is important to note that one of your languages must either be English or Afrikaans to qualify for a Higher Certificate.

Diploma pass requirements

- Must obtain at least 40% for your Home Language.
- Must obtain at least 40% for **three** other High Credit subjects (**Four**, including your home language).
- Must obtain at least 30% for **two** other subjects.

Bachelor's Degree pass requirements

- Must obtain at least 40% for your Home Language.
- Must obtain at least 50% for **four** other High Credit subjects.

Must obtain at least 30% for **two** other subjects

REMARKING PROCESS: R548-00 (INCLUDING VAT) PER SUBJECT

Only online applications will be accepted - **SACAI portal: <http://portal.sacai.co.za>**

Only remarking online application process:

- **Opening date: Friday, 22 July 2022**
- **Closing date: Friday, 05 August 2022**

Candidates may apply for re-marking of examination answer scripts immediately after receiving their SACAI NSC Statement of Results. The closing date for application for a re-mark is usually announced on the back of the Statement of Results.

- **A candidate may only apply for the remark in a subject if the mark for the subject is within 3% of a higher symbol, e.g., 27%, 37%, 47%, 57%, 67% or 77%**
- A candidate may apply for the remark of his/her examination scripts at the prescribed fee. The application may only be completed online.
 - Candidates are urged to get their statements of results from their SACAI NSC designated examination centre or SACAI Independent school where they wrote the NSC exams.
 - Result queries should be submitted for investigation within 30 days after the release of results.
 - Candidates must ensure that names and identity numbers (Copy of ID document) reflect correctly on their statement of results and report any required corrections to the SACAI Examination Board before **2 August 2022**.

VIEWING OF SCRIPTS: R306-50 (INCLUDING VAT) PER SUBJECT

May only be done after a re-mark. The closing date for applications is **7 days after release of re-mark** results.
