1. RE-MARK OF EXAMINATION SCRIPTS

Requests for the re-mark of examination scripts can be done online via the SACAI portal at www.sacai.org.za

A candidate may only apply for a re-mark in a subject if the mark for the subject is within 3% of a higher symbol, e.g. 27%, 37%, 47%, 57%, 67% or 77%.

Candidates must ensure that names and identity numbers (Copy of ID document) reflect correctly on their Statement of Results and report any required corrections to SACAI before 30/05/2023.

CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY INTO MAY/JUNE EXAMINATIONS

- Candidates who were absent with a valid reason (medically unfit, death in the immediate family or other special reasons) from one or more external question papers, may register for the May/June examination. If a subject consists of more than one paper, all papers for the subject have to be rewritten.
- Candidates who want to improve their overall achievement status, or only want to improve the achievement of a subject, may register for the May/June examination. Where an irregularity is being investigated from the November exams, provisional enrolment for May/June examination may be granted to the candidate concerned, pending the outcome of the investigation.
- Candidates who were unable to write or complete one or more of the previous November examination question papers for reasons **other than illness/injury or death in the family**, may apply to write the May/June examination, provided that a written report is submitted by the SACAI NSC Institution or Principal of the Independent School to the Chief Executive Officer of SACAI, Mr Keith Maseko.

NB: Documentary proof substantiating reason for absenteeism must be submitted to SACAI to ensure entry to the May/June examination. Documentary proof can consist of the Statement of Results of the previous November examinations or previous 2014 to date Umalusi certificates or previous Grade 12 Statements of Results.
